Day 1 to Day 5 – Andaman Islands Overview

Chances are you probably haven't heard of these islands, but that's because to a large extent they are undiscovered. The Andaman Islands have some of the best beaches in the world, indeed Radha Nagar on Havelock Island was named Beach Best In Asia by Time in 2004. Conde Naste Traveller in January 2010 called the Andaman Islands the "ultimate tropical mystery" and having "unearthly perfection." Picture long stretches of clear blue water and pristine white sand, surrounded by forest....in short, a picture postcard.

It also has some of the best scuba diving (PADI courses also available) and snorkelling. There is also an opportunity to go kayaking and overnight trips to nearby islands to explore limestone caves.

Come prepared to discover nature at its best.

Day 1 to Day 5 – Andaman Islands Itinerary

Day 1

Arrive in Port Blair, Andaman Islands and transfer to Havelock Island.

Day 2

Day trip to North Passage Island. On Merck Bay Beach you can have a long swim or explore the coconut plantation and forest

Day 3

Day trip to Swiftlet Rock and Tamarind Camp. Snorkel around Swiftlet Rock – the best snorkelling site in Andaman for experienced snorkellers. At 11am proceed to Tamarind Camp. Relax, take your turn kayaking, explore the forest or simply snorkel around the reef and the drop-off near Tamarind Camp.

Day 4

At your leisure.

Day 5

Return to Port Blair and overnight stay there.

Day 6 to Day 10 – Vythiri Overview

There is a reason why Indians call the state of Kerala God's Own Country. It has some of the most stunning scenery around.....waterfalls, rivers meandering through lush green forests and all the things you'd expect of a Garden of Eden paradise – unspoilt panoramic nature.

Accommodation – Vythiri

Vythiri Haven room – All meals included. The room has a Jacuzzi spa, lounge to entertain, a lovely bedroom and a balcony overlooking the creek.



Day 6 to Day 10 – Vythiri Itinerary

Day 6

Arrive in Vythiri.

Day 7

Day trip to Soojipara Waterfalls. 32km away from Vythiri, these waterfalls are a reminder of simple beauty, peace and serenity.

Day 8

Day trip to Muthanda Wildlife Sanctuary. 55 kms from Vythiri and a 5 hour activity, you will get the chance to see elephants, spotted deer and sloth bears, to mention a few.

Day 9

Relax in the swimming pool, have a drink out on the balcony of your room and take in the scenery at leisure.

Day 10

Day trip to Banasura Sagar Dam. 30 kms from Vythiri and a 4 hour activity, this is the largest earth dam in India at about 3,500 acres. Good opportunity for picnic and boat ride. In the evening take a walk with the naturalist through the nearby tea plantation.

Day 11

Depart for Bombay.



Day 11 to Day 13 – Wine Tour Overview

India's wine industry has been slowly taking off over the last 5-10 years, with Nashik (4 hours drive from Bombay) charging ahead. In fact India is one of the fastest growing regions for wine in the world, with one estimate putting the growth in consumption at 25%-30% per annum from 2009 to 2012.

So take a weekend out and experience wine tastings by four of India's best brands – Sula, Zampa, York and Tiger Hill, as well as explore three of the vineyards at your leisure.

Day 11 to Day 13 – Wine Tour Itinerary
